



Wallace Franklin Miller

March 15, 1938 - October 22, 2019

Wallace Franklin “Frank” Miller was born March 15, 1938 in Macomb, Michigan and passed October 22, 2019 in Long Beach, California. He was one of 16 children born to the late William and Ruth Miller. In 1955, at age of 17, upon becoming a young father and husband to Marjorie Morrow (deceased), Frank enlisted into the United States Air Force (USAF). He served in the United States as well as many countries overseas often working on top-secret assignments. He was a veteran of the Vietnam War and retired after 20 years of service as Technical Sargent in 1975. One of his great achievements was receiving the Air Force Commendation Metal for Meritorious Service.

After retiring from the military, Frank went on to have a long career with Lockheed Aircraft in Ontario and Palmdale, California. He worked on many projects involving the C-130 (aircraft carrier) as his speciality in the USAF. While at Lockheed, he was a member of the infamous Skunk Works and worked on many innovative programs. He was respected by all of the people he ever had the chance to work with and loved for his ability to approach problems and deep concerns for the people he supervised and managed.

It was at Lockheed where Frank met Jeanette Reese, and they became friends. They eventually fell in love and were married in 1992. The two resided in Westminster, California and remained together until his passing.

When not at work, one of Frank's favorite pastimes was fishing. He loved to be out on a boat with his family whenever he had a chance. It was family, he learned, that was the most important thing in his life. He loved his children deeply and would have done anything for them.

In addition to Jeanette, Frank was survived by 9 of the 16 siblings, his five children Deborah Miller-Logue, Suzanne Grant, Tracey Morris, Stephen and Michael Miller, two step children Peter Davey and Jenny Davey, nine grandchildren and several great children. He will be deeply missed.
